

2024 PanCAN PurpleStride 5K Walk-Run Event Details for ANC Presentation

Pancreatic Cancer Action Network ("PanCAN") Mission Statement - To take bold action to improve the lives of everyone impacted by pancreatic cancer by advancing scientific research, building community, sharing knowledge, and advocating for patients.

- 1. 2024 will be the 14th annual PurpleStride 5K Walk-Run held in Washington, DC
- 2. The premier sponsor of this year's event is the Washington Capitals
- 3. The proposed dates are Friday, April 26 (Set-Up) and Saturday, April 27 (Event)
- 4. The race will start at 9:00 am and end at 11:00 am
- 5. Approximately 2,800 walkers and runners are expected
- 6. The race will use the established Penn Ave. 5K course route
- 7. Penn Ave. from 12th-14th St will close on Friday from 7:00 pm to midnight for set up
- 8. Full road closure on Saturday will be in effect from 8:00-11:00 am
- 9. All roads except Penn Ave. from 12th -14th St will re-open on Saturday at 11:00 am,
- 10. The remaining section of Penn Ave. will re-open at 2:00 pm on Saturday.
- 11. Turn-by-turn directions (course map)
 - o The course starts on Penn Ave. between 12th and 13th St., heading east
 - o At 3rd St, the course turns right, heading south to Independence Ave.
 - o At Independence Ave., the course turns right, heading west to 7th St
 - At 7th, the course reverses direction and heads east to 4th St.
 - At 4th St, the course turns right, heading south to D St.
 - The course turns left at D St, heading east to 3rd St.
 - o At 3rd St, the course turns left, heading north to Penn Ave.
 - o At Penn Ave., the course turns left and returns to 12th and Penn Ave.

12. Public safety assets:

- Approximately 100 MPD officers on site throughout the course
- Eight DPW blocking vehicles
- o A fully staffed medical tent and a stand-by ambulance
- Two bike-mounted medics

13. Activities Timeline:

- Wednesday, April 24
 - Event staff posts Emergency No Parking signs along the course route
- Friday, April 26 at 7:00 pm
 - MPD closes Penn Ave. from 14th St to 12th

- DPW positions blocking vehicles at these intersections:
 - Penn Ave. & 14th St
 - 13th & E St
 - Penn Ave. & 12th
- DPW tows illegally parked vehicles
- Vendor Load-in begins.
- Saturday, April 27
 - 5:30 am
 - Event staff arrives on-site
 - MPD expands the Penn Ave. closure to include 14th to 9th
 - DPW tows vehicles parked illegally on Penn Ave. from 9th-14th St.
 - Final vendor deliveries
 - 8:00 am MPD begins closing roads along the rest of the course
 - 8:57 am Runners and walkers in position at the starting line
 - 8:58 am "All Clear" received from MPD
 - 9:00 am Walk-Run starts
 - 9:20 am The first runner crosses the finish line
 - 11:00 am The course is closed. Stragglers move to the sidewalk
 - 11:00 am All roads except Penn Ave. from 12th to 14th
 - 2:00 pm Penn Ave from 12th to 14th St re-opens
- 14. Permits, Approvals, and Agency Support:
 - JRP will work with the following agencies and organizations to secure the required permits, approvals, and race day support.
 - ANC 6D & ANC 2C letters of support
 - MSETG conditional approval
 - MPD parade permit and race day staffing
 - DPW towing service and blocking vehicles
 - DDOT public space permit
 - DOH approval
 - FEMS approval
 - ORM approval of the COI
 - DOB (DC Department of Buildings) permit
 - DLCP (Department of Licensing and Consumer Protection) permit
 - NPS race day staffing
 - USPP race day staffing
 - WMATA letter of support
