

What is a TOPP?

- Traffic Operations and Parking Plan (TOPP) is a plan that outlines strategies to manage travel for large crowds to and from big venues, such as Audi Field, Nationals Park and Capital One Arena. It's a public document, updated annually.

- TOPP is a collaborative effort that involves multiple government agencies and community stakeholders:
 - District Department of Transportation (DDOT); Metropolitan Police Department (MPD)
 - Department of Public Works (DPW); Department for Hire Vehicles (DFHV)
 - Advisory Neighborhood Commissions (ANC 6D and ANC 6/8F)
 - DC United / Washington Nationals
 - Southwest BID
 - Capitol Riverfront BID

Why do we need a TOPP?

Audi Field capacity: 20,000

Nationals Park capacity: 41,000

Maximum impact: up to 60,000

Anthem DC Capacity: 3,200 seats (up to 6,000 standing)

- Minimize the traffic and parking on residents of neighboring areas, businesses, and commuters
- Reduce pedestrian-vehicle conflicts
- Provide efficient travel information to patrons
- Encourage the use of Metrorail and other transit options
- Enforce restrictions during games and events
- Manage the pick-up and drop-off activity of rideshare vehicles




Figure 2 | Pre-Game Street Closures and Restrictions During Audi Field Events




Figure 3 | Post-Game Street Closures and Restrictions During Audi Field Events




Figure 5 | Pre-Game Street Closures and Restrictions During Nationals Park Events
